 - Needs surface temp. at or below freezing and visible moisture
 - Two kinds Rime/Clear both deadly!
 - Carburetor—vs—fuel injection icing

 - Cold Weather Survival Packet
 - Always be dressed for the seasons and expect to walk to your destination!
 - Trash bags and duct tape (survival pack musts!)
