November Safety Meeting
8 November 2005

The meeting commenced at 1900 hours discussing new licenses, achievements, up and coming plans for the Aero Club.

The safety briefing was presented by Mr. Cater Fox discussing the importance of planning for survival and survival equipment. A FAA DVD was shown outlining principles of survival gear.

1. The majority of the time, only those items on your body will make it out of the accident site with you. Pack and wear your gear, vests are highly recommended.
2. Wear and carry extra clothing appropriate for the weather for all locations you plan to over-fly.
3. For over water flights, bring water survival gear (acquired on base with notice to manager) floatation devices required for flights outside airplanes gliding distance of land.
4. Carry items to create fire, magnesium fire starter or life boat matches highly recommended.
5. Water and water purification tablets, food, and knife all important for trip.

The presentation concluded with questions and the meeting was adjourned at 2100.
