CRM for the single pilot

1. FLY THE AIRPLANE (Aviate, Navigate, Communicate)
2. Recognise the problem and evaluate the urgency
3. Identify available resources inside the aircraft with you:
 - a. Checklists
 - b. Operating handbook
 - c. Other occupants (pilots or not – anyone can read or hold a checklist)
 - d. Your training
4. Identify the resources outside the cockpit
 - a. ATC
 - b. Unicom or CTAF, potential A&P onsite
 - c. Flight watch or 121.5
 - d. If all else fails, cell phone
5. Survey all available resources for potential fixes for the problem
6. mote hands in the pot the more likely you are to come up with a unique answer to a problem
7. **ABOVE ALL ELSE, FLY THE AIRPLANE FIRST!!!!!!!!!!**
